

#### Enrolment Call for "Food Authenticity PhD Excellence Academy"

#### Article 1 General Directions

Pursuant Decree n. 270 22/10/2004 of the Ministry of Education, University and Research, the School of Advanced Studies on Food and Nutrition activates "Food Authenticity PhD Excellence Academy "for the year 2023. The PhD School will last a total of 40 hours and it will include lectures and experiential activities, The School will be held in presence in the province of Parma, in a residential facility with full board and in shared room, from 7 to 10 October 2023.

Lessons will be held in English and at the end of the project an attendance certificate will be issued.

The PhD School is structured in 3 phases as follow:

- 1. a first online warm-up. During this phase, from 17 April to 6 May 2023, a miscellary of material will be proposed (articles, videos, case studies, etc.) to focus the attention on various issues related to the school topic. In addition to recorded lessons, participants will be exposed to training material aimed at honing basic skills necessary to take part in the second phase.
- 2. a second phase of 4 days, in presence, from 7 to 10 May 2023. This phase will include lectures, followed by experiential and role playing activities. The involvement of foreign professors, or of Italian ones working abroad, will allow a broader overview of the state of the art in Europe and in the international context;
- 3. a third follow up phase by remote, from 11 May to 5 June 2023, to conclude and consolidate the notions assimilated during the School.

The PhD School is part of a project funded by the Emilia-Romagna Region (resolution of the Regional Council n. 1625 of 18/10/2021), which provides funds to University of Parma in relation to "Emilia Romagna Food Science Advanced Doctoral Training Programme" created by the School of Advanced Studies on Food and Nutrition.

The programme will follow a multidisciplinary and integrated approach, allowing the students to acquire a proactive vision rooted into the scenario analysis, horizon scanning, and supply chain mapping.

The participants will acquire knowledge, skills and tools to fight against food fraud in the industrial environment, also considering the impact of the socio-economic drivers and the climate change on the global food system.

The course will bring together the most advanced technical skills from STEM and the methodological approach from social sciences, also considering the major certification schemes. Particular attention will be paid to communication to consumers.

## Article 2 Admission Requirements

The PhD School is thought for PhD students from all over the world and engages in all areas related to the field of food science.

If not English mother tongue, to all participants is recommended a minimum knowledge of English (B2 level). This factor will be taken into account during selection.

There are 20 places available. The PhD School will be activated in the event of reaching minimum 10 participants.

#### Article 3 Selection Admission and Documents Submission

Enrolment for the selection will start on 20 February 2023 and will remain open until 12 a.m. (Italian time) of 2 April 2023. Access the PhD School website <a href="https://phooder.unipr.it/">https://phooder.unipr.it/</a> and:

- b) upload the following documents:
  - 1. Curriculum vitae
  - 2. Motivational letter (in English),
  - 3. Degree certificate with list of exams and marks
  - 4. Certification or self-certification of knowledge of the English language
  - 5. Copy of a valid identification document
  - 6. Tax ID number (if in possession)
  - 7. Reference letter

All candidates will be admitted to the selection with reserve; the School of Advanced Studies on Food and Nutrition will at a later stage exclude those candidates who do not possess the admission requirements stated in this announcement.

In the event of false or misleading declarations presented by the candidate for the purposes of enrolment, without prejudice to the criminal sanctions referred to in art. 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28 December 2000, the same candidate loses the right to enrol. Any false or misleading declarations may lead to exposure to juridical action for damages by the parties concerned.

Any applications received after the deadline will be evaluated only if the maximum number of places available is not reached.

## Article 4 Selection Procedure

Admission to the PhD School is subject to a positive judgment based on the evaluation of CV, qualifications and motivational letter.

Eligibility is granted with a minimum score of 60 points; the maximum score is 100.

The Judging Commission is appointed by the President of the School of Advanced Studies on Food and Nutrition.

The selection for the participants will be based on their academic performance (with particular consideration to possible titles or publications), curriculum vitae, motivations expressed and reference letter.

The selection will take into account the geographical origin of the applicants in order to promote the creation of an international environment.

### Article 5 Creation and Approval of the Ranking

Among the eligible candidates, those who have placed themselves in a useful position in the ranking compiled on the basis of the overall score, will be admitted to the PhD School in relation to the number of places available.

In case of ex-aequo, the one who obtained a higher score in the evaluation of the curriculum vitae has precedence; in case of further equality, the younger candidate precedes.

Within fifteen working days from the enrolment closing date, the administrative office will notify participants of their admission to the PhD School via e-mail.

#### Article 6 Enrolment Fee for Participants

The enrolment fee for participants is partially covered by the funds obtained within the "High-level training projects in the technological, economic and cultural field for a European region of knowledge and attractiveness" presented under the invitation referred to in DGR 1200/2021 - resolution transmission Regional Council n.1625 / 2021 and managerial determination n.19459 / 2021 of the Emilia-Romagna Region. The candidates selected for enrolment in the school will have to cover the cost of 600,00€, inclusive of the boarding, in shared room, in the facility where the school will take place. ### Article 7 Enrolment and Submission of Documents

Within fifteen days of the publication of the ranking, candidates will receive communication of the successful admission by e-mail. To secure their position in the PhD School it is necessary to send written confirmation to <a href="mailto:advancedstudies@unipr.it">advancedstudies@unipr.it</a> and to pay the respective enrolment fee.

Those who fail to confirm the position or fail to make the payment within the deadline will be considered as having renounced and the ranking will be scrolled.

#### PURPOSE AND METHOD OF THE PROCESSING

The data provided is processed by University of Parma, as Data Controller, for institutional purposes, such as carrying out administrative, teaching and research activities. The processing is necessary for the pursuit of its institutional purpose, pursuant to art. 6 of the European Regulation on the protection of personal data n. 679/2016 (hereinafter referred to as GDPR for brevity), and in compliance with the general principles of transparency, fairness and non-excess referred to in art. 11 of the Personal Data Protection Code, Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (hereinafter referred to as the Code for brevity), as well as the principles provided for by art. 5 of the GDPR, with particular regard to the lawfulness, to the use of data for specific, explicit, legitimate purposes, in a manner relevant to the processing, respecting the principles of data minimization, accuracy, limitation of conservation, integrity and confidentiality, responsibility.

The data collected will be recorded, processed and stored for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. Personal data will be collected by University of Parma and may be communicated for exclusively institutional purposes, and in line with the legislative and regulatory provisions of reference to external subjects such as CINECA, Er-GO, ALMA LAUREA, Parma University Hospital and to persons or external companies acting on their behalf. The data will be processed with the aid of electronic tools; digital systems are equipped with measures to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

#### NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND CONSEQUENCES OF ANY REFUSAL TO PROVIDE

The provision of data for the purposes referred to in the previous point is essential for carrying out the institutional purpose. Refusal to provide them will not allow University of Parma to provide any service.

#### RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

As an interested party, the candidate has the rights (Article 7 of the Code and Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, and 21 of the GDPR) to ask the data controller for confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data, the access to the same data, to know the origin of the data, to obtain the limitation of processing, updating, rectification or cancellation of the same and the right to oppose the processing based on particular reasons.
